

STOLEN WAGES SETTLEMENT



Continuing registration form (deceased Claimant)

Important note: This form is only to be used to continue claims for Claimants (not registered representatives) that registered a stolen wages claim before 21 November 2019 and have since passed away.

On 8 September 2020, the Federal Court amended the Stolen Wages Settlement Distribution Scheme to allow a spouse, or where there is no living spouse, a child to continue a claim for a Claimant that registered before 21 November 2019 but has passed away. If a Claimant has no living spouse and more than one child, the children should discuss who will continue the claim for their parent.
