Claimants and registered representatives have until **5.00pm on 9 October 2020** to provide their address, bank account details and identity verification document (photo ID). There are still 2,867 claimants and registered representatives who have not provided the required information and documents (claim data) to the Stolen Wages Information Centre.

If you still need to provide information please do so via email to avoid the possibility of missing the deadline. Information received after 5.00pm on 9 October 2020 may result in a claimant or registered representative not receiving a payment.

Distribution statements will be mailed to all eligible claimants and registered representatives after 9 October 2020. Mail could take several weeks to be delivered to your address so please allow sufficient time for this to occur.

Payments will be made to eligible claimants and registered representatives before 6 December 2020.
